



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Public Hearings Scheduled for Labrador Inuit Settlement Area (LISA) Regional Land Use Plan

A draft Regional Land Use Plan has been adopted-in-principle by the Provincial and Nunatsiavut Governments for the purpose of public hearings. The Regional Planning Authority (RPA) prepared the draft plan for the Labrador Inuit Settlement Area (LISA) in northern Labrador. The RPA was appointed in 2007, in accordance with the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement, to direct preparation of a Land Use Plan for LISA. The plan will guide development and the use of land, water and resources in LISA.

A commissioner has been appointed by the RPA to hold the public hearings and consider representations on the draft plan. Public hearings to consider representations on the draft Regional Land Use Plan for LISA shall be held as follows:
