



UPDATE ON THE REGIONAL LAND USE PLAN FOR LISA

September 26, 2011

The draft Regional Land Use Plan has been adoption-in-principle by the Provincial and Nunatsiavut Governments as required under the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement.

The Regional Planning Authority for the Labrador Inuit Settlement Area (LISA) has appointed Mr. Bob Warren as the commissioner who will hold public hearings and consider representations regarding the draft Regional Land Use Plan for LISA.

The hearings will take place in the five Inuit communities of Nain, Hopedale, Makkovik, Postville, and Rigolet, as well as Mud Lake, Happy Valley-Goose Bay, North West River and St. John's. Notice of the Hearings is posted on this website. The hearings will commence on October 17th.
