



UPDATE ON THE REGIONAL LAND USE PLAN FOR LISA

January 5, 2012

The Commissioner appointed by the Regional Planning Authority held public hearings from October 17th to November 2nd, 2011 in Nain, Hopedale, Makkovik, Postville, Rigolet, Mud Lake, Happy Valley-Goose Bay, North West River and St. John's. Upon completion of the hearings the Commissioner prepared a report and submitted it to the Regional Planning Authority. The Authority has reviewed the report and submitted it for consultation to the Provincial and Nunatsiavut Governments.

Upon receipt of the comments from the two governments, the Authority will review the comments and will revise and finalize the Regional Land Use Plan for LISA. The Authority will then submit the final draft Regional Land Use Plan to the two governments.

The Nunatsiavut and Provincial Governments will receive the final draft Plan and after reviewing it and consulting with each other can:

- (a) approve the draft Plan with or without conditions;
 - (b) modify the draft Plan;
 - (c) reject the draft Plan and substitute another Plan,
- as it applies to their area of jurisdiction.

The two governments have granted an extension to complete the Plan and submit it to them by March 31, 2012.
