



UPDATE ON THE REGIONAL LAND USE PLAN FOR LISA

July 20, 2011

The Regional Planning Authority has submitted the revised Plan to the Provincial and Nunatsiavut Governments for adoption in principle as required under the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement. The revised Plan is based on comments received at the consultation meetings held earlier this year and comments received from both governments.

The draft Regional Land Use Plan for LISA has been adopted in principle by the Provincial and Nunatsiavut Governments.

The draft Regional Land Use Plan is in the process of being printed. The schedule for the public hearings by the Commissioner and copies of the revised draft Plan can be obtained when it is available in a couple of weeks.

Notification of the hearings will be sent to everyone who attended the consultation meetings this year and provided their contact information. Notice will also be sent to those who requested to be notified of the hearings.
